


# CASE




### The CASE Model

The CASE model is an instructional system that provides four major areas of support to promote solid classroom instruction using rigorous and relevant STEM-based lessons while enhancing student learning. The four areas of teacher support include curriculum, professional development, assessment, and certification.

Curriculum includes detailed instructions, assessments, rubrics, and hands-on activities, projects, and problems with each lesson. CASE enhances the level of STEM education in agriculture.





## **CASE Certification**

Teachers successfully completed 50-100 hours of intense **professional development** during a CASE Institute to be certified to teach a CASE course.

# Serving Industry Needs

According to USDA research, an average of 35,400 new U.S. graduates with expertise in food, agriculture, renewable natural resources, or the environment are expected to fill 61% of the expected 57,900 average annual openings. CASE builds student interest in these disciplines through engaging and hands-on lessons. CASE students are prepared for colleges or careers related to agriculture, food, renewable natural resources, engineering, or the environment to meet the high demand needs of industry.

CASE is supported by agriculture business and industry partnerships through course development, as well as scholarships and grants for teachers to attend professional development and equip their classrooms. 






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
