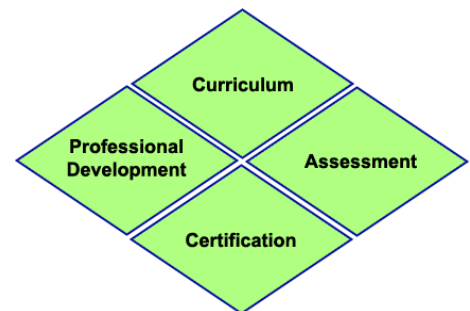


### The CASE Project

- **What** is the CASE project?  
The Curriculum for Agricultural Science Education™ (CASE™) is a program that is designed and written by agriculture educators for agriculture educators. CASE is a structured sequence of agriculture courses and serves as a model for elevating the rigor and relevance of agricultural education. Classroom instruction is enhanced to meet the needs of today’s agriculture students without sacrifice to FFA and SAE instruction.
- **Who** does the CASE project benefit?  
CASE benefits teachers, students and the industry of agriculture by enhancing agricultural education programs to develop and produce well educated and highly-skilled graduates.
- **Why** is CASE different?  
CASE is much more than just curriculum. In fact, CASE is a system of instructional support for the classroom teacher like no other resource in agricultural education today. CASE integrates teacher professional development, peer-mentoring, and external support systems to assist the classroom teacher in all aspects of sound teaching practice. CASE will provide students a rigorous balance of science, mathematics, and English language situated in agriculture subject matter. Student motivation towards learning agriculture subject matter is enhanced with relevant learning connections by using practical instructional approaches. Student learning in the classroom will be facilitated by the use of inquiry-based activities, projects, and problems.
- **CASE Model**  
The CASE four dimensional approach to teacher support includes curriculum, professional development, assessment, and certifications. Each area contributes to the validity of a CASE program by ensuring that teachers are properly equipped and trained and student learning is clearly accountable.
- **CASE Vision**  
The CASE vision is to enhance agricultural education rather than replace traditional curriculum. CASE will provide the vehicle to expand the range of influence of agricultural education to non-traditional school districts commonly associated with suburban and urban settings. Regardless the setting, our intent is to improve the learning experiences for the agriculture student by improving teacher performance.
