CASE CERTIFICATION

Enhances agricultural education with inquiry and project-based learning to prepare the next generation of the agricultural workforce through teacher education and professional development.

CASE Institutes

CASE Institutes (CIs) are specialized professional development for comprehensive CASE courses. Institutes are five to nine days of professional development to address the element of instruction expected by teachers of a CASE course.



In-Person

Teachers attend the entire training at the host site, lodging and meals are provided.



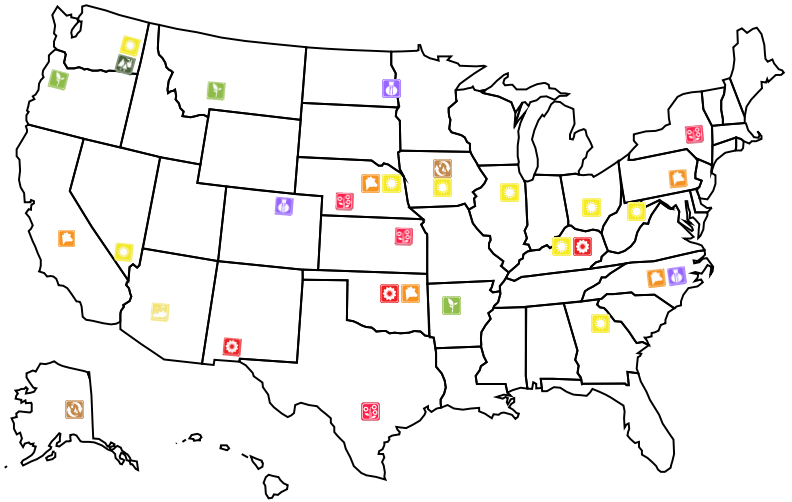
Virtual

Teachers attend the entire training online. Teachers will receive materials via mail, and are responsible for their lab space.



Hybrid

Teachers receive training both virtually and in-person based on the course.



Scholarships
